Tuition is \$225 per week for the full day schedule of 8:30am to 3:30pm or \$160 per week for the half day schedule of 8:30-12:30. Before school care is available 7:30-8:30am for \$25 per week and after school care is available until 5:30pm for \$45 per week. Spanish Immersion is available for all camps for an additional fee of \$30 per week. Tuition is due by the first Monday of each camp. Tuition not paid within two days of the due date will be assessed a \$25 late fee and withdrawal may be required.

A \$100 application fee for new students and a registration fee of \$50 for summer are due for students not registered during the 2019/20 school year. Off campus excursions for Elementary/Adolescent camps may include an additional fee and a minimum enrollment requirement. Camps may be canceled or age levels combined if a minimum enrollment is not reached two weeks prior to camp start date. Spirit shirts are optional and available to order at www.prepschoolshirts.com.
